

#### Marlene Hilton Moore



Marlene Hilton Moore has defined a distinctive profile in Canadian visual arts marked by outstanding achievements at local and national levels, particularly in the complex arena of Public Art and Monuments.

Hilton Moore has an extensive public exhibition schedule of solo and group exhibitions. Her sculptural work engages the human form, particularly the head. Her work is also engaged in the stereotypes that pressure the identity of women in today's society as well as concerns regarding our human relationships as a whole. Sound is a significant factor including recorded voice, music and sounds of nature in her audiovisual installations.

Hilton Moore has been a recipient of many Public Art Commissions over the last twenty years. Significant works include the prestigious *Valiants Memorial*, Ottawa, *Two Freedoms*, McMurtry Gardens of Justice, *Sir Wilfrid Laurier* for WLU, *Wiidookdaadiwin*, Simcoe County, *Flowers at Our Feet*, Toronto, the *Borden Legacy Monument*, CFB Borden, *The Volunteers/Les Benevoles*, Halifax and most recently the *Centennial Bugler*, Vimy, France.

She has received awards from the Canada Council for the Arts, The Ontario Arts Council and the Sheila Hugh Mackay Foundation. Her work is in the collection of the Canada Council Art Bank, Agnes Etherington Art Gallery, Sir Wilfred Laurier University, the University of Winnipeg, and many other public and private collections.

In 2014 Hilton Moore received the City of Barrie's *Excellence in Arts Award*. In 2010 Hilton Moore retired from her professorship at the School of Design and Visual Arts, Georgian College following a distinguished 25-year teaching career.
