Etienne Labbé trained as a molecular biologist in Montréal and Toronto, and has divided his time between explorations in art and science. Born in Québec City, he grew up in the Saguenay region and now lives and works in Toronto. Labbé has experimented with several art forms, including sculpture, watercolour, mixed media and photography. His work consists of rapidly shifting explorations of scale, color, movement, light and mood. Movement is used as a creative and transformative force by which ordinary landscapes are altered to reveal a hidden reality that is at once familiar and enigmatic. Etienne Labbé's work is held in several private collections across Canada.
